Notes

This is a walk of 3.6 miles with total ascent/descent over the walk of 280 feet and is easy underfoot, except after rain!

The walk starts from The Abingdon Arms, Beckley, heads down Common Road then branches North West towards Noke returning to Beckley and The Abingdon Arms via Noke Wood and Church Street.

Route Notes

- From the pub turn right and walk through the village past the church and school until you reach the end of Church Street.
- On your left you will see a footpath that takes you over the field towards Noke Wood. Follow the footpath through the wood until you reach the open field and then follow the path that skirts the field edge to the west and north-westward until you reach the village of Noke. (In the village there is plenty of scope to walk around it on a variety of paths.)
- To return to Beckley take the footpath 100 metres to your left on the road through Noke. This path heads southwards towards Lower Woods Farm and then Upper Woods Farm.
- 4 Just beyond the farm the path heads in a south easterly direction skirting the edge of Noke Wood until you reach Common Road. Follow the road eastwards until you reach the village and pub.
