
Walk 12 – Stanton St John Circular



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Notes

This is a walk of 2.9 miles with total ascent/descent over the walk of 222 feet and is easy underfoot, except after rain!

The walk starts from Stanton St john Village Hall, skirts Stanton Great Wood and returns to the Village Hall.


Legend

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SSJ = Stanton St John, Alphabetical letters refer to approximate points on the accompanying little marked-up map, SGW = Stanton Great Wood, LHS = left hand side, RHS = right hand side.

Route Notes

- Start: SSJ Village Hall Car Park (which is 100m from the village church, along 'Middle Road')
 Walk across car park to open fields beyond. Go through black iron gate into field.
 Walk through field downhill to (gate / wooden bridge / gate) (D) at bottom and go through.
 Across field, through gate
 Across field keeping fairly close to fences on LHS to near gate
 onto road.
 DO NOT go through gate
 but turn hard right up the grassy field (1) towards the wood (SGW)
 Go through galvanised gate
 - Pass through small slightly wooded area with fenced Stanton Great Wood (SGW) on LHS
 - Continue on path with fenced SGW on LHS and distant Forest Hill village on 'starboard bow'
 - Over little wooden bridge and through galvanised metal gate.
 - Continue on footpath close to SGW on LHS
 - **O**, **O** Go through galvanised iron gate and fork leftish to keep near SGW fence.



- **O**, **O** Go through galvanised gate on left as cinder track ends keeping SGW close on LHS
- Continue on path with SGW on LHS and go through gate W
- continue close to SGW fence on LHS then through gate **V** on a flat bridge over a stream.
- Continue on path across field to the road turning left towards SSJ. At the church, turn left and reach the Village Hall and the end of the walk.
