
Walk 3 – Sydlings Copse

Notes

This is a walk of 3.4 miles with minimal ascent/descent of 140 feet and easy underfoot, except after rain!

The walk starts from The Abingdon Arms, Beckley, heads South towards Headington, crosses the B4027, continue to Sydlings Copse and returns to Beckley and the pub via Sand Path.

Sydlings Copse is owned and run by the Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire Wildlife Trusts. More information can be found at https://www.bbowt.org.uk/nature-reserves/sydlings-copse

Route notes

- From the pub bear left and walk southwards along Roman Way and onto Sand Lane. Keep walking due south, crossing over New Inn Road, and on to a footpath that takes you to the B4027.
- At this junction walk to the right for a few metres until you reach a footpath continuing southwards. After 725 metres you will see a clear trail on your right taking you to the gate into Sydlings Copse, a nature reserve managed by BBOWT. There is a map and guide at the gate which indicates a circular walk through the nature reserve that leads you back to the gate.
- Retrace your steps to return to the village. On reaching New Inn Road you can turn to your left and follow the road into the village, following the road around until you return to the Abingdon Arms.
